She is currently a Visiting Scholar and Associate Director at the Elliott School of International Affairs' Institute for African Studies at George Washington University where she teaches Women and Leadership in Africa, as well as the Role of Multilateral Diplomacy in Global Politics.

The Ambassador is a graduate of the University of Dar es Salaam in Tanzania, holds a M.A. in Government and Politics from St. John's University in New York and has a post-graduate Diploma in International Law.
